

WORLEY/PRENGLE AND FOUNDERS SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

The annual distributed income from this endowment will be used to provide scholarship funding in the Cullen College of Engineering to Chemical Engineering undergraduate student(s). The annual distributed income shall be spent for student scholarship(s) based on the following criteria:

- a. Scholarship prospect exhibits leadership qualities as determined by the Cullen College of Engineering Scholarship Committee.
- b. Scholarship applicant should demonstrate an interest in pursuing a career in chemical engineering.
- c. Scholarship applicant must be a certified full-time undergraduate chemical engineering degree-seeking student in good standing at the University of Houston. Applicants must be at least Sophomores and have a min CHEE GPA of 3.0.
- d. Scholarship recipient must maintain a GPA in accordance with the standards set by the Cullen College of Engineering Scholarship Committee.
- e. Scholarship recipient may accept other scholarships and grants in conjunction with **The Frank L. Worley, Jr. Scholarship**.
- f. Funds can be used to cover expenses for tuition, books, fees, and/or supplies for the coming academic semester.
